Brisbane Aquifer Project Construction of new water mains - Algester

The Brisbane Aquifer Project is an integral part of Brisbane City Council's commitment to the *Regional Drought Strategy* and part of a number of obligations Council must meet under State Government legislated Water Regulations to ensure the region's water supply for the future.

As part of this project, construction of new water mains will start in Algester this month.

The new water mains will carry groundwater, sourced from recently established local bores, to a new water treatment plant to be constructed on the corner of Paradise Road and the unformed Dalmeny Street at Algester.

Starting after Easter, construction of a section of the new water main will occur along the southern side of the Council parkland between Paradise Road and Algester Road.

These works will be conducted between 6.30am and 5.30pm Monday to Saturday and will take approximately two weeks to complete.

To ensure the safety of the public, access to the pedestrian/cycle path through this section of the park will be closed during construction.

While these works are carried out you may notice some additional noise in the area, however every effort will be made to keep disturbances to a minimum.
