## **BICENTENNIAL BIKEWAY UPGRADE** Important construction notification – evening bikeway closures

Construction of the Bicentennial bikeway upgrade between Cribb Street and Park Road, Milton is progressing well with completion expected by late July 2009, weather permitting.

Before the upgraded Bicentennial bikeway opens some final works are required, including dismantling the temporary boardwalk and completing works on the pathway.

For safety reasons and to minimise disruption for users, these works will be carried out at night between 8.00pm and 5.00am, Sunday to Thursday from 21 June 2009 until early July, weather permitting. This will assist to accelerate the completion of this project.

Throughout the night works the bikeway will be closed to all users. During this time cyclists should use the footpath on the Milton side of Coronation Drive and pedestrians should use either footpath along Coronation Drive. We apologise in advance for any temporary inconvenience caused and appreciate your patience while these works are carried out.

The project will increase the level of service offered by the busiest bikeway in Brisbane City and provide improved facilities. The project includes:

- separating pedestrian and cyclist movements
- constructing a 3.5m wide cycle path
- · constructing a 2m wide pedestrian path.

Further upgrades to the Bicentennial bikeway are expected to be undertaken by Council and the Hale Street Link Alliance in the future.
