Jindalee shared pathway project

As part of Lord Mayor Campbell Newman's commitment to provide \$100 million in bikeway infrastructure over four years, Brisbane City Council is constructing the Jindalee shared pathway.

The Jindalee shared pathway is an important link in Brisbane's bicycle and pedestrian network and connects Jindalee with the existing Centenary Highway bikeway.

The bikeway connects Mount Ommaney Drive and Koorungal Drive. The project will involve:

- construction of a 384 metre shared pathway that is three metres wide
- construction of a 52 metre single span bridge at the Koorungal Drive end of the project.

Construction for the project commenced in February 2009 and is expected to conclude around June 2009, weather permitting.

Council is committed to keeping the community informed about the project and upcoming works and will continue to provide updates throughout the construction process.
