SYLVAN ROAD ON-ROAD CYCLE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT Construction commencement

Brisbane City Council is pleased to announce that construction of the Sylvan Road on-road cycle improvement project at Toowong will commence in late August 2011, weather permitting.

The Sylvan Road on road cycle improvement project is part of Lord Mayor Graham Quirk's commitment to provide \$100 million in new bikeway infrastructure over four years (by 2012).

The project will deliver a number of improvements to on and off road cycling facilities along Land Street and Sylvan Road, enhancing safety and providing improved connections for pedestrians and cyclists.

Works will include:

- resealing and remarking Sylvan Road (from Croydon Street to the rail overpass)
- installing and extending traffic islands in Land Street and in Sylvan Road at the Milton Road intersection to provide safer crossings and refuge for cyclists and pedestrians
- footpath works and installing bike ramps to provide stand up areas for cyclists and pedestrians
- new on-road bicycle line markings and improvements to existing markings
- upgrading Bennetts Street, Miskin Street, Croydon Street, and Jephson Street intersections with Sylvan Road with new bicycle ramps, changing traffic line markings and new or changed traffic islands and kerb and channel.

Construction is expected to be completed in approximately three months, weather permitting. Temporary road lane and footpath closures may be required during construction, however traffic control will be used to ensure the safety of motorists, cyclists and pedestrians.

Where possible, works will be done outside peak traffic hours and every effort will be made to minimise disruption to the local community during this work. Advance notification of particularly noisy works or major access changes will be provided to properties within the works area.
