In 2013, 11 per cent; in 2014, 20 per cent - clearly indicating that building safer paths is enticing more and more women out there, which is great to see.\" You also repeated these figures at a BQ Q&A night on 30 April 2015. This 11% figure is not in line with any of the regular counts conducted by CBD BUG at various sites - http://www.cbdbug.org.au/bikeway-counts/ 

A presentation by Andrew Macbeth of BCC TPS on 26 May 2014 to Velocity had a slide entitled \"Gender Balance 2013\" indicating that from a sample of 25,251 over 3 sites in 2013, 17% of all cyclists counted were female.

Could you please indicate which day or days these 11% and 20% figures were based on, which sites, and how many cyclists were sampled? I hope this will not take long, and this time could you please reply by email as requested in the box above instead of by snail mail.
