Please note: Data Analysis allows a 3 month lag for extracting and providing offence data. This allows for completeness of data and time for the offence notice to be forwarded from Queensland Police to Department of Transport and Main Roads for entering into the system. The 3 month lag includes the 28 day period for the alleged offender to pay or respond to the offence notice. Some offence categories will still be understated due to the prolonged time it takes for these matters to be finalised (e.g. Drink Driving offences).

* Please Note: It is not possible to identify the method used to fine drivers for passing too close to a cyclist in violation of S144A of the TORUM Regulation

** Please Note: The offence under S258 is for the absence of either or both bell and brakes. It is not possible to identify which one the cyclist is being fined for.
