Dear Lord Mayor

I refer to your letter of 3 July 2015¹ (LM02957-2015) in response to our email of 11 June 2015² about standard bikeway entrance treatments, also known as deflection rails or banana bars.

In your response you wrote that Council was "... looking at where bikeway entrance treatments are no longer required ... " and that removal "will commence this financial year".

The CBD BUG is aware that Council has installed double deflection rails on Macquarie Street, St Lucia as part of the recent upgrading of existing bikeway infrastructure. Aside from that instance, we are asking for an update on which sites mentioned in our original correspondence you are targeting for removal, and when you intend to remove them. We would also appreciate an update of which other sites have been selected, and the criteria by which they have been chosen.

In your letter you also stated that "CBD BUG will be consulted as part of "the investigation to review standard designs for bikeway infrastructure." Could you please advise when this review will be undertaken, as we have yet to be consulted.

We look forward to you updating us on these issues.
