SYLVAN ROAD PEAK PERIOD BIKE LANE TRIAL
Community feedback survey

Brisbane City Council is committed to improving cyclist safety and is undertaking a peak period bike lane trial on Sylvan Road, between Milton Road and Land Street, Toowong. The 12 month trial concludes in May 2017.

The Sylvan Road peak period bike lane trial started in May 2016 and is an innovative Council safety initiative that trials no standing zones as dedicated bike lanes from 6-9am for inbound traffic and 4-7pm for outbound traffic, Monday to Friday along Sylvan Road.

As part of the trial evaluation, Council is seeking feedback from users of Sylvan Road via an online survey about the effectiveness of the trial and the future layout of the road once the trial concludes in May 2017.

The online survey will be available from **Thursday 1 June to Wednesday 21 June 2017** via the project webpage on Council's website www.brisbane.qld.gov.au and search for 'Sylvan Road'. The survey consists of 15 questions and takes approximately 10 minutes to complete.

Feedback from the survey, along with community feedback received throughout the trial and observations from traffic activity, will be considered in the decision-making for the future layout of Sylvan Road once the trial concludes in May 2017. In the interim, peak hour bike lanes will remain and continue to operate on Sylvan Road between Land Street and Milton Road.

Council has notified the local community and businesses about the survey, and we would appreciate any assistance you can provide in sharing this information with your members.
