Dear Lord Mayor

This letter is to request Council install kerb ramps on Stanley Street, South Brisbane, to improve connectivity of the shared path that links the South Bank Boardwalk to Stanley St.

At present this shared path abruptly terminates at Stanley St between the heritage-listed Victoria Bridge Abutment and the base of the current Victoria Bridge.

An image from Google Street View is provided with this letter to assist Council's identification of this location.

However, a kerb ramp at this location would enable people riding bikes to ride more directly onto the road, instead of dismounting at the end of the shared path or instead riding further along the Stanley Street footpath that is often crowded with pedestrians.

Additionally, a kerb ramp in the concrete centre dividing median on Stanley Street at this location is also requested, to allow cyclists to directly enter / exit the shared path from the other side of Stanley Street, such as in the case of cyclists who have just ridden from the City on-road across the Victoria Bridge.
