Dear Mr Campbell

I refer to your email of 1 August 2017 to the Honourable Anastacia Palaszczuk MP, Premier, regarding the Bicentennial Bikeway and the Queen's Wharf Brisbane (QWB) project. As these matters fall within the portfolio responsibilities of the Honourable Kate Jones MP, Minister for Innovation and Tourism Industry Development and Minister for the Commonwealth Games, your correspondence has been forwarded to this office for consideration. The Minister has asked me to respond on her behalf.

On 21 December 2017, the Queensland Government announced QWB was a step closer after Economic Development Queensland (EDQ) approved the Destination Brisbane Consortium (DBC) Plan of Development application with a number of conditions. Additional design development and refinement will be undertaken by DBC once construction contractors are procured.

The Honourable Mark Bailey MP, Minister for Transport and Main Roads, has previously announced the government would undertake a feasibility study to determine the best long-term cycling-related solutions in and around the precinct.

As you may be aware, Minister Bailey stated that cycling groups would be fully consulted throughout the study and consultation will commence shortly.

This is a continuation to the public consultation undertaken previously with stakeholders impacted by this project dating back to 2013.
