My dear Lord Mayor

I write concerning the Brisbane City Council Active Transport Strategy 2012-2026 modal share targets for cycling.¹ This document set a target of 2.5% of all transport journeys in Brisbane to be made by cycling.

The 2016 Census Method of Travel to Work results were released in November 2017 and your previous letter (ref LM05856-2015²) stated that BCC's estimate of 2011 modal share for bicycles of 1.6% was "drawn from Census journey to work data for that year".

As your administration never tires of repeating that \$220 million was allegedly spent on bicycle infrastructure in the period 2008-2016, I would hope that BCC Transport Planning and Strategy is closely monitoring overall usage trends to see if the Active Transport Strategy targets are being met.

Please answer the following questions.

- 1. Have you estimated the 2016 modal share for bicycles?
- 2. If so, what estimate did you obtain? If not, why not, and when and where will an estimate be published?

I look forward to your prompt response to these issues.
