Dear Dr Bean

Thank you for your emails of 30 January and 14 February 2018 about Give Way signage for cyclists at the intersection of Coronation Drive and Archer Street, Toowong. I also note your feedback regarding a waste collection truck not stopping at a 'Stop' sign at Archer Street. I appreciate you bringing these matters to my attention.

The safety of all road users is of paramount importance to me and I asked Ms Chloe Wright, Strategic Planner from Council's Transport Planning and Strategy (TPS) to investigate the signage further. I understand Ms Wright spoke with you on 14 February.

I can advise that the 'Give Way' signage at the intersection of Coronation Drive and Archer Street was installed over 10 years ago to address poor sightlines for cyclists and improve safety at the Archer Street crossing. However, as Ms Wright explained, given the high volume of cyclists that use this bikeway and the safety concerns you have raised, TPS will investigate alternative treatments to the Archer Street crossing as part of Council's Active Transport Network Plan. I understand Ms Wright will update you as this investigation progresses.

In the meantime, if you have any further enquiries about this matter, please phone Ms Wright on 3403 8888.

With regard to the poor behaviour shown by the waste collection truck operator, I can confirm Council's Waste Services has raised this matter with the contractor directly, who in turn have reminded the truck operator of the Queensland road rules.

I trust this information is of assistance and thank you for contacting me.
