Dear Minister

The CBD BUG was surprised and pleased at your announcement at the Brisbane Bicycle film festival that stage 4 of the North Brisbane Bikeway has now been opened to tenders.

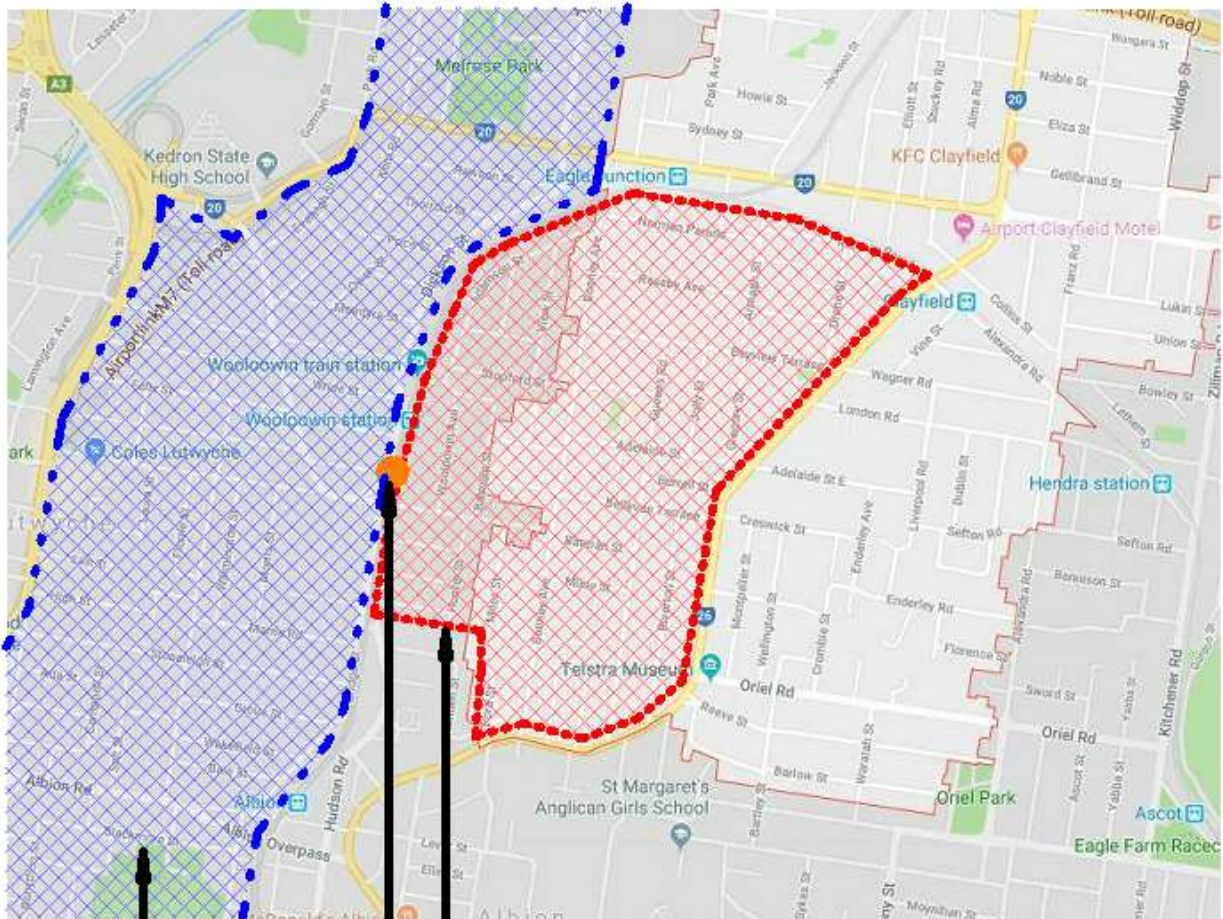
Due the protracted history of this project the CBD BUG does not want to delay the delivery, which the CBD BUG views as vital in the enabling of everyday practical cycling. That said, during the BCC consultation last year, a slight amendment to improve the catchment of the project was raised by the BUGs (Figure 1). While the project is highly regarded for its quality of design it is difficult for people on the east of the rail line to access it easily. To resolve this issue it was suggested traffic lights be installed at the Fraser St Bridge. The CBD BUG still strongly supports through traffic being prevented from using Fraser St via its reconfiguration as a cul-de-sac. The installation of the lights is to simply allow improved access and safety for people coming from the east side of the railway tracks.

As stated above the CBD BUG in no way wants to further delay this project. We hope this suggested amendment can be incorporated without unduly complicating the project nor delaying delivery.
